Job Description

Availability:

The women's Division One season runs from mid-August until May, with a short break, mid-season in December. Games are on Saturdays roughly from 10:00 - 1:00 pm. Our trainings will be held on Tuesday and Thursday evenings in the tri-cities (locations TBD) from 7:30-9:30pm

Main Responsibilities:

- Attend the majority of all trainings and Saturday games
- Develop a competitive training program based on team goals and game play
- Establish and maintain player engagement and development through practices, meetings and goal setting sessions
- Be familiar with and advocate for United's inclusive values and the laws of the game including fair play
- Organize practice sessions and coordinate the work of assistant coaches (if applicable)
- Participate in team selection with the Women's Team Selection Committee
- Fulfill any other related duties as assigned by the Executive.

Eligibility:



- Experience with Adult 15s rugby rules and game play
- Completion of the following coaching certifications
 - Rugby Ready
 - Concussion management
 - Player welfare
- Advanced coaching qualifications are considered an asset but are not necessary to apply
- Must be a Canadian Citizen or already be eligible to work in Canada. **United Rugby is unable to sponsor out of the country**
